The Feast of Lights Service is led by the St. Luke's Adult Choir and the Episcopal Youth Community.




Lenten Devotional Resources will be available beginning February 1st on the church website.



In conversations led by Chad Shores, we'll read and discuss Farrer's ideas on the nature of God and faith that he expressed from the pulpit.




